

BREVARD COUNTY USNG MAPS – INSTRUCTIONS TO MAKE HYDRANT ICONS LOOK CORRECT

In order for the HYDRANT ICONS to look as designed, you *may* need to install the True Type Font file provided.

When viewing the PDF, IF the fire hydrant symbol looks like an ampersand (&) and a number (3), one on top of the other, you will need to follow the directions below:

Copy the file **esri_11.ttl**, available in this directory, into your Windows\Fonts installation directory.

Typically, this would be C:\Windows\Fonts.

The ICON update may not occur until after re-boot/re-start of computer.

When done, the Hydrant Icons will look like this:
